- Have at least a 3.0 GPA
- Priority will be given to applicants who have participated in any East Central IL
   AHEC activities, or for applicants who commit to participating in an AHEC related

- A completed and signed **application** (attached)
- Current high school or college transcript
- Two letters of recommendation (on organizational letterhead)
- Letter of acceptance or class schedule of college applicant is enrolled in
- A typed listing of:
  - Post-secondary schools (college, vocational, or career center) you have attended and number of credits earned
  - Honors and/or Awards you received and the year you received them
  - o Clubs and/or Organizations you currently belong to
  - o Job Shadowing Experiences (health career related) you have participated in
  - o Volunteer Activities and/or Employment you have completed in the past 2 years
- A typed, 1 page personal statement that provides a personal profile of yourself that includes:
  - Why should you receive this award
  - What your professional goals are
  - o How you will contribute to your chosen profession
  - How you intend to practice in a <u>rural</u> community
  - How you will impact that <u>rural</u> community
  - How this award will help you attain your goals

Applications will not be considered if all documents are not received by the deadline.
